## Mini-Bio

Cid Wilson is the Sr. Vice President & Retailing Equity Analyst for Kern Suslow Securities, an investment firm based in New York, NY. He has worked in the financial services industry since 1993. In 2006, Wilson was ranked #1 financial analyst in his field by Forbes in its annual ranking of the Best Wall Street Financial Analysts in America. He serves on the Ethnic Advisory Board for PepsiCo Inc.

In addition to his corporate energies, he serves on the boards of directors of some of the leading non-profit organizations in the nation including LatinoJustice PRLDEF since 2005, the National Council of La Raza (NCLR) since 2008, and Dominicans On Wall Street (DOWS) since its founding in 1997. He is the former National President of the Dominican American National Roundtable (DANR) from 2003 to 2007.
